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TEACHER CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

ESTABLISHING KINGDOM WORSHIP

Join Morgan Choice as you prepare your heart and mind to dance with passion, freedom and purpose. Explore dance and worship and how to incorporate prompts and exercises to help you and your students advance in transformative moments.

RULES AND AGREEMENTS

- Video Class Pass may only be used for filming dance classes (cannot record Countdown to Transformation, The Gathering, DR Showcase, DR Production or Faculty Finale)
- Video Class Pass may not be shared with ANY other participant of the convention.
- Video Class Pass badge must be worn at all times in order to videotape during the weekend.
- Misplacement of Video Class Pass will result in purchasing of new class pass.
- Any videotaping device that you use to capture footage of class must have the class pass. This includes cell phones, flip cameras and video cameras.
- Any misuse of class pass (filming unnecessary footage of teachers, students or parents, asking teachers for extra choreography and/or repeating the choreography) will result in loss of class pass.
- You may not disrupt other dancers while filming (i.e. sitting in a spot where dancers are dancing, going near the stage area, etc.)
